

- B. This entire section will be moved from the Special Exception section of Chapter 4, Conditional and special Exception Uses, to the Conditional use section of Chapter 4. This means these uses will be allowed in the B-3 General Commercial District, as long as the conditions above are met.
- C. Make the necessary changes to the Table of Uses to show these uses as conditional uses in the B-3 General Commercial District, and to renumber the sections in Chapter 4 based on this use being added to the conditional Use Section.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall become effective on the date the state law prohibiting tattoo parlors is reversed and signed into law.
